

"Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time"

Entrance Antiphon: "Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the end of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice." Cf. Ps 48 (47): 10-11

Communion Antiphon: "Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed the man who seeks refuge in him." Ps 34 (33): 9

Reflection for the Sunday: On this Sunday, the readings emphasize God's empowerment in the face of adversity. In Ezekiel, God strengthens him to speak to rebellious Israel, showing that God never abandons His people, even when they stray. Ezekiel's mission teaches us that we are called to speak the truth despite resistance, relying on God's strength. Paul's message in the second reading highlights that our weaknesses allow Christ's power to shine, encouraging us to embrace our struggles and trust in God's strength. The Gospel recounts Jesus' rejection in Nazareth, illustrating the importance of faith in receiving God's blessings. This episode reminds us to maintain our belief in Jesus despite opposition, as faith opens the door to His healing and new perspectives. 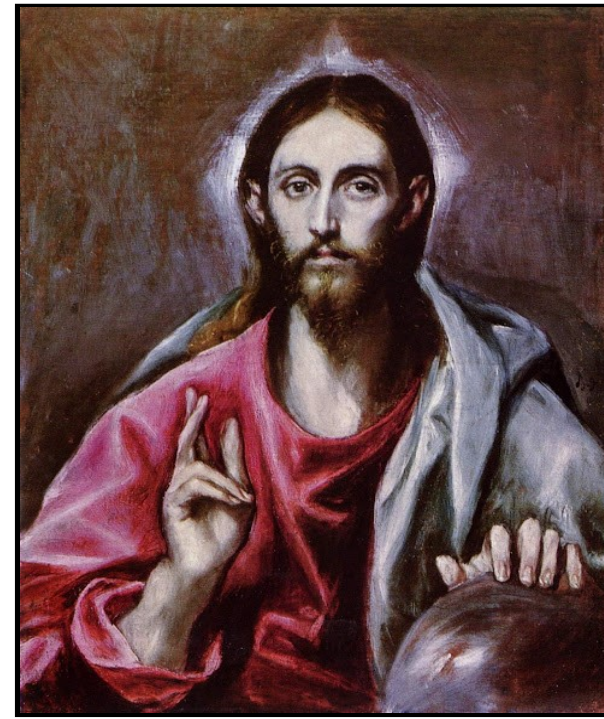
