

"Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time"

Entrance Antiphon: "See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good." Ps 54 (53): 6, 8

Communion Antiphon: "The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, has made a memorial of his wonders; he gives food to those who fear him." Ps 111 (110): 4-5

Reflection for the Sunday: The readings for this Sunday emphasize God's constant care, Christ's unifying sacrifice, and Jesus' compassionate leadership. In Jeremiah, God condemns leaders who mislead His people and promises to guide them Himself, ensuring their safety and appointing wise, just leaders. Ephesians highlights how Christ's sacrifice unites us, breaking down barriers and making us one family in God. In Mark, Jesus, moved by compassion, teaches the crowd like a shepherd guiding his flock. These readings assure us of God's unwavering care, the peace and unity we have in Christ, and the importance of compassionate leadership.
