**Entrance Antiphon:** Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice; turn to the Lord and his strength; constantly seek his face. Cf.. Ps 105 (104):3-4

**Communion Antiphon:** "Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, as a fragrant offering to God." Eph 5: 2

**Reflection for this Sunday:** The readings for the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B highlight God's deep love, mercy, and the transformative power of faith. In Jeremiah 31:7-9, God promises to restore His people from exile, particularly focusing on the weak and vulnerable, such as the blind and the lame, showing that His care extends to all, regardless of their condition. Hebrews 5:1-6 presents Jesus as the compassionate High Priest, chosen by God to offer Himself as a sacrifice for our sins. His priesthood invites us to be compassionate and merciful toward others, following His example. In Mark 10:46-52, Bartimaeus, a blind man, calls out persistently to Jesus, and through his faith, he receives healing. Bartimaeus not only regains his sight but chooses to follow Jesus, showing us the courage and trust needed to follow Christ, even at personal cost. These readings encourage us to place our trust in God's restoration, embrace the compassion of Jesus, and walk faithfully with Him, confident that His love and mercy are always available to us.
