## "Second Sunday of Advent"

**Entrance Antiphon:** O people of Sion, behold, the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart. Cf. Is 30:19,30

**Communion Antiphon:** Jerusalem, arise and stand upon the heights, and behold the joy which comes to you from God. Bar 5:5; 4:36

Reflection for this Sunday: Isaiah's prophecy of the shoot from the stump of Jesse is a powerful reminder of God's ability to bring life from what seems dead. This promise of the Messiah fills us with hope as we await the Lord's coming. Paul echoes this hope in the second reading, encouraging us to live in harmony and welcome one another as Christ has welcomed us. The Gospel introduces John the Baptist, who calls us to prepare the way of the Lord through repentance. His message is urgent and uncompromising: the kingdom of heaven is at hand, and we must bear fruit that reflects true conversion. Advent is a season of preparation, not just for Christmas but for Christ's transformative presence in our lives. Let us heed John's call, examining our hearts, clearing away the obstacles of sin, and making room for the Savior who comes to bring peace, justice, and renewal.
