Entrance Antiphon: "O come, let us worship God and bow low before the God who made us, for he is the Lord our God." Ps 95 (94): 6-7

Communion Antiphon: "Let them thank the Lord for his mercy, his wonders for the children of men, for he satisfies the thirsty soul, and the hungry he fills with good things." Cf. Ps 107 (106): 8-9

Reflection for this Sunday: The 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time invites us to reflect on God's holiness, our unworthiness, the power of His grace, and our call to follow Jesus. In the readings, Isaiah is overwhelmed by God's glory, Paul acknowledges his past failures, and Peter falls to his knees in humility—yet God calls each of them to serve. Their stories remind us that God does not seek perfection but willing hearts. His grace transforms our weaknesses into strength, enabling us to share our faith and live as His disciples. Like the fishermen who left everything to follow Jesus, we, too, are called to trust in His plan, let go of what holds us back, and commit ourselves to His mission. May we embrace His call with humility and courage, trusting that He will guide and equip us for the journey ahead.

Making a Pilgrimage: The Jubilee Year offers everyone opportunities to participate in jubilee events at the Vatican and in their own dioceses. Pope Francis opened the first Holy Door, marking the beginning of the Jubilee of Hope, at St. Peter's Basilica on December 24, 2024. Other holy doors were opened at the Rome basilicas of St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, and St. Paul Outside the Walls. "In Catholic tradition, the Holy Door represents the passage to salvation—the path to a new and eternal life, which was opened to humanity by Jesus," explained Pope Francis in Spes Non Confundit (Hope Does Not Disappoint), the papal bull officially proclaiming the Holy Year of 2025. In crossing the threshold of the Holy Door, the pilgrim is reminded of the passage from chapter 10 of St John's gospel: "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture." Passing through the Holy Door expresses the decision to follow and be guided by Jesus, who is the Good Shepherd. For pilgrims who cannot travel to Rome, bishops around the world have designated cathedrals, shrines, and churches within their dioceses as special places of prayer for Holy Year pilgrims, offering opportunities for reconciliation, indulgences and other events intended to strengthen and revive faith.


