Entrance Antiphon: "Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the end of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice." Cf. Ps 48 (47): 10-11

Communion Antiphon: "Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed the man who seeks refuge in him." Ps 34 (33): 9

Reflection for this Sunday: The 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, invites us to reflect deeply on God's tender care, the power of the Cross, and the joyful vet challenging call to discipleship. In the first reading from Isaiah, we are comforted by the image of God as a loving mother, embracing her children with peace and compassion, reminding us that even in times of trial, His blessings and presence surround us. This reassurance calls us to gratitude and trust, encouraging us to recognize and rejoice in the daily signs of His care. St. Paul, in the second reading, points us to the Cross of Christ as our only source of glory—not worldly success, but the profound love and salvation won for us through Jesus' sacrifice. This message leads us to live with humility and deep faith, knowing that our strength comes not from ourselves, but from Christ who died and rose for us. In the Gospel, Jesus sends out the seventy-two disciples, empowering them to proclaim peace, heal the sick, and rely solely on God's providence. Their mission, though difficult, is filled with joy because it draws them closer to Jesus and His work. Their example teaches us that true discipleship involves trust, simplicity, courage, and perseverance—even in the face of rejection. Altogether, this Sunday reminds us to rejoice in God's care, embrace the Cross with humility, and commit ourselves fully to the mission of love and peace. May we, like the early disciples, go forth with joy, strengthened by God's grace, and eager to share His peace with a world in need.


