The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Entrance Antiphon: "I saw the holy city, a new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband." Cf. Rev 21: 2

Communion Antiphon: "Be built up like living stones, into a spiritual house, a holy priesthood." Cf. 1 Pt 2: 5

Reflection for this Sunday: Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the cathedral of the Pope and the "Mother and Head of all Churches." Built by Emperor Constantine in the fourth century, the Lateran was the first Christian basilica, standing as a visible sign that faith in Christ had triumphed over persecution. This feast reminds us that while sacred buildings are holy, the true temple of God is Christ Himself—the place where heaven and earth meet—and through Him, each of us becomes a living temple of the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus drives the merchants from the temple, calling for renewal and purity of heart. From His side on the Cross flowed blood and water—the living stream of grace that brings life to the world, just as the river in Ezekiel's vision flowed from the temple to renew creation. Every parish church, including our own, is a sign of that same presence: a house of prayer where Christ dwells among His people and from which His grace flows outward to heal and sanctify the world. As we honor the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, let us also renew the dedication of our own hearts, so that our lives and our parish may always be true dwelling places of God's love.




