

"Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time"

Entrance Antiphon: "The Lord said: I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction. You will call upon me, and I will answer you, and I will lead back your captives from every place." Jer 29: 11, 12, 14

Communion Antiphon: "To be near God is my happiness, to place my hope in God the Lord." Ps 73 (72): 28

Reflection for the Sunday: The readings for this Sunday are a call to do the work of the Kingdom of God with the gifts we have been given. The first reading sings the praises of the worthy wife who uses her talents to labor for good. The psalm tells us that those who follow the Lord are blessed. The second reading reminds us that we are children of light and goodness. And in the gospel Jesus tells the parable of the talents and praises the servants who used their resources wisely. The Parable focuses on the idea of stewardship and responsible use of resources. It encourages people to make the most of what they have, rather than hoarding or hiding it. The message in the gospel is about action and accountability. It tells us that what we're given—whether it's money, skills, or opportunities—should be utilized for a greater good. The idea is to grow and multiply these gifts, presumably for the benefit of the community or, in the religious context, for the Kingdom of God. Fear holds back the third servant, and he fails to do anything productive. The parable suggests that doing nothing with your resources or abilities is not an option; it's a failure to meet a basic responsibility.
