

"Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time"

Entrance Antiphon: "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall." Cf. Ps 27 (26): 1-2

Communion Antiphon: "The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength." Ps 18 (17): 3

Reflection for the Sunday: The readings on this Sunday explore themes of faith, hope, and family through scripture readings. The first reading recounts the story of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. Despite their disobedience and resulting hardships, God offers a glimmer of hope through the promise of a future offspring who will overcome evil. This foreshadows Jesus' arrival, signifying God's enduring love and mercy. The second reading from Corinthians emphasizes perseverance through trials. While we may face difficulties, they are temporary and serve to prepare us for the eternal life that awaits. This passage encourages us to maintain a strong faith, trusting in God's promises and drawing strength from the hope of everlasting life. The Gospel reading presents Jesus' definition of family. When challenged by those who don't understand him, Jesus clarifies that true kinship lies in following God's will. This redefines family beyond blood relations, creating a spiritual bond among believers. We are called to broaden our love and embrace fellow believers as brothers and sisters in Christ. Overall, the readings remind us that faith offers hope and guidance. Despite facing challenges and even opposition, we can find solace in God's unwavering love and the promise of eternal life.
